## **East Front Neighborhood Cleanup is Saturday April 27 at 8am**

Our annual neighborhood cleanup is funded by the City of Wichita. We neighbors and volunteers do cleanups for pride and tidiness!

### Rules

- Do not share our cleanup on social media.
- Do not bring extra items into the neighborhood for the cleanup. East Front is bound by Hillside, Kellogg, I-135 & Douglas.
- The cleanup will happen rain or shine.
- Thanks for volunteering! Meet up at Volutsia and Douglas at 8am. Wear long sleeves, gloves and closed shoes.
- Please help us load your items.
- We will have a donations bucket. Donations are appreciated but not required. They will help us pay for our website, events and newsletter.

### **Set out on the curb up to 2 days before April 27**

- Metal recycling will be picked up Friday night.
- Separate mattresses from trash. They will be picked up for recycling 8am-noon.
- Bag, box or bundle all trash.
- Bundle all tree waste and brush no more than 4 ft long and 12 inches in diameter.
- No concrete or construction materials.
- No hazardous materials such as paint, pesticides, appliances with Freon, etc.
- Bring tires to the tire truck at Douglas & Volutsia (8 max per residence). No semitruck or racing slicks.

- Open Streets in the Nomar Neighborhood on Sunday May 5 from noon-4pm. This free event will be along 21st Street from Broadway Avenue to Woodland Park. The road is closed to traffic and open for biking, walking, running, live music and dancing, entertainment, food, art, yoga, and more.
