Outdoor Watering Tips

Limit watering to once per week.

Water just enough to keep root systems alive; allow lawns to go dormant.

Water before 10 a.m.

Do not overseed lawns this fall.

Water just enough to fill up an upside down frisbee, once a week.

Your lawn should go dormant but not die utilizing this schedule until the drought is over. wichita.gov/501/Drought-Update


